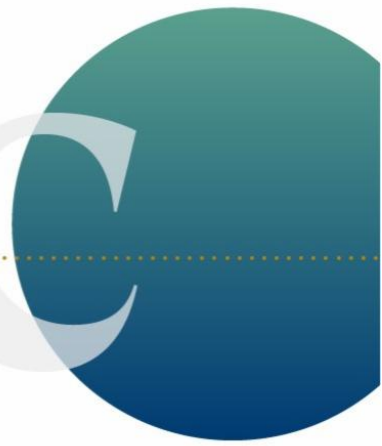

Dear Merchant,

Today marks a historic day in the battle against COVID-19. Earlier, Governor Gavin Newsom terminated the executive orders that put into place Stay at Home Order and Blueprint for a Safer Economy, as well as phased out the vast majority of actions put in place since March 2020.

What this means for your business? There are no longer capacity limitations for retail, restaurant, movie theatres, gyms and bars - as well as most types of business. The County Tier System has been terminated along with no social-distancing requirements.

The California Department of Public Health has also updated the statewide masking policy to match the CDC's guidance, lifting mask requirements for vaccinated individuals who can also socially gather without masks in most circumstances. Certain places of business are still required to mask up including healthcare and childcare services.

Please note, CalOSHA is in review of the new masking guidelines and will vote on June 17th to officially adopt the new policy and through executive order will go into effect immediately if passed by the board. Until then, employees are still required to wear masks even if they have been vaccinated.
